With respect to the supplied table of WA's top 4 emitters and wannabe emitters, here are a few notes which I hope will be illuminating.

The figure for **Woodside** is the latest published company total for Australia, which is essentially the WA figure, as there are few if any other currently emitting Woodside facilities elsewhere – plus the previously published anticipated emissions figure for the Pluto processing facility, which has come on-stream over the past year or so.

The figure for **Verve** is the latest published company total, and includes power stations such as Cockburn, Collie, Geraldton, Kemerton, Kwinana, Mungarra, Pinjar, West Kalgoorlie & Worsley.

The figure for **Alcoa** is the latest published company total, and includes bauxite mining, alumina refineries & power stations.
